SUBJECT: VERIZON CALNET 2 LOCAL GOVERNMENT CUSTOMERS

This bulletin is to inform Local Government Customers that Verizon has provided the lower rates offered in CALNET 3 to CALNET 2 customers since June 1, 2014. Rates will revert back to the higher CALNET 2 rates beginning March 1, 2015 for Local Government Customers that do not have a signed CALNET 3 Authorization to Order (ATO) on file with Verizon by February 15, 2015. If you have already submitted an ATO for CALNET 3 services no further action is necessary.

The California Department of Technology and Verizon have agreed to extend the CALNET 2 Contract to accommodate the transition to the new CALNET 3 Contract. Local Government Customers that have not completed a CALNET 3 ATO are required to submit a new ATO in order to transition services to the CALNET 3 Contract.

Pursuant to the terms of the CALNET 2 extension, the ATO that was signed for CALNET 2 Services will continue to be honored as follows:

- For a CALNET 2 service without a comparable CALNET 3 service to transition to, the service will be available under CALNET 2 through January 29, 2016.
- For Local Government Customers who are unable to transition to CALNET 3 until fiscal year 2015/2016 due to fiscal budget constraints, an exception will be granted, provided that this is communicated to Verizon by February 15, 2015.

The CALNET 2 contract expires January 29, 2016. Effective January 30, 2016, pricing for any services that remain on the CALNET 2 Contract will convert to Price Guide rates on file with the California Public Utilities Commission and/or the Federal Communications Commission.
